

International Comparisons

Compared to the 11-country average, Canada has lower:

- ▶ Total health expenditures per capita (-15%)
- Annual growth in total and government health expenditures 2005-2015 (-10%, -25%)
- Hospital beds and hospital days per capita (-34%, -31%)
- ▶ Long term care beds (-21%)
- ▶ MRI units and CT scanners (-41%, -40%)
- ▶ Physicians and nurses (-23%, -20%)


International Comparisons

Compared to the 11-country average, Canada has higher:


- Pharmaceutical expenditures per capita (+19%)
- ▶ GPs per 1000 population (+12%)
- Physician visits per year (+31%)




Health Expenditures Per Capita vs. Health Care Quality Ranking


2003 First Ministers Health Accord

Strength of Primary Care: Provincial Ranking




Ontario's Primary Care Reform Strategy

Features of High-Performing Primary Care Systems

- Patient registration with a primary care provider
- Absent or minimal primary care user charges
- Primary care gatekeeping
- Local primary care governance
- Alignment of payment systems for primary care physicians with health system goals




Features of High-Performing Primary Care Systems
